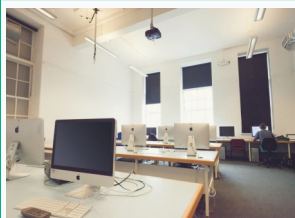
Director's Cut by Casey Van Haren

It wasn't long ago, 2009 to be exact, that the library was only open five days a week, Tuesdays-Fridays. The newly built library opened Saturday, October 10th 2009, and due to the recession and budget cuts, hours were reduced. There's a saying in library land, cutting libraries in a recession is like cutting hospitals in a plague. However, our library, as have others, withstood the test of time. From the Ancient Library of Alexandria, in Egypt, to keeping up with trends in library services, such as makerspaces, digital media labs and computer classes, libraries are more popular and are needed more than ever. Our community is the heart of our library. Without input and investment from our community we would not be as successful with our services and we would more than likely not be relevant anymore.

Offering services and hours that fit with our community's needs are very important to me and our staff. It took nine years, but here we are, adding Sunday hours, 1 p.m.-5 p.m, starting November 18th for the first time ever. We are very excited to be open seven days a week! As this is a pilot project that will run until April 2019, we have no doubt that it will be successful. Our community has spoken and we have heard!
